"Tell me about a time you made a mistake and how you fixed it."

Weak Response

- Not answering the question
 - "I don't make mistakes."
 - Well, I'm very careful not to make mistakes. Very careful. I understand that mistakes can be costly for a company such as yours and so when I do my work, I check it again and again and again just to make sure that nothing is wrong because – I don't want to make any mistakes.

Strong Response

- Describes a mistake that you actually made but one that is not detrimental to the position you are interviewing for.
- Demonstrates that you had a strong relationship with your supervisor.
- Indicates your problem solving skills via story -(STAR method).


