



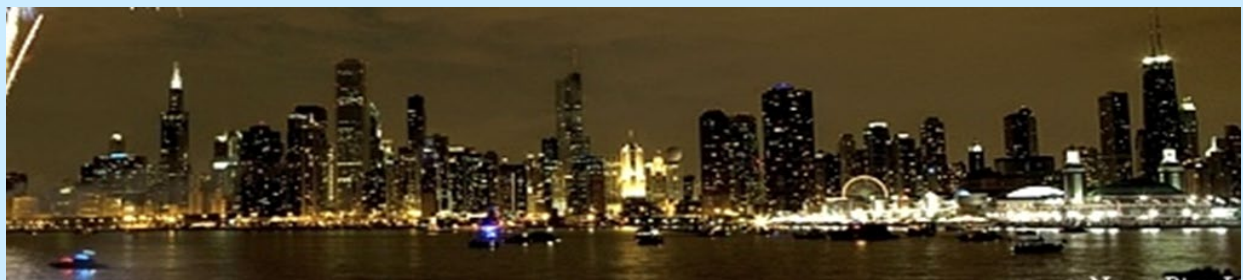

Nomination submission deadline is December 1st. The winner will be notified by December 12th, announced during the Chapter's monthly meeting on December 14th, and will be asked to present an overview of the winning project during the 2023 Leadership Forum one of the Chapter's annual signature events where leaders, influencers and decision makers share knowledge to promote and positively drive the value of project, program, and portfolio management. A nationwide press release would follow.

Instructions

- I. Nomination Process
 - a. The person who submits the nomination is the primary contact.
 - b. The nomination application will include a brief overview of the project including, how it was identified, planned, and executed.
 - c. The Nominator will be notified of the status of the nomination at the conclusion of the evaluation process.
 - d. The winner will be announced during the monthly chapter meeting in December.
 - e. The winner will be asked to present an overview of the project during the next Leadership Forum, one of the Chapter's signature events.

- II. Eligibility Criteria
 - a. Nomination is open to any individual, team, or organization in and around the Chicagoland metropolitan area.
 - b. The Lead Nominator may submit only one candidate for the Project of the Year award.
 - c. The project must already have been completed/deployed prior to nomination submission.
 - d. PMI Chicagoland Leadership team members are not eligible to submit nominations, nor receive the award.
- III. Requirements
 - a. Provide concise responses on why/how this nomination exemplifies each key assessment area.
 1. ***Ways of Working:*** *Applying the right technical management technique at the right time to deliver winning results*
 2. ***Power Skills:*** *Leadership and competency in guiding and motivating the project team*
 3. ***Business Acumen:*** *Function-specific or domain-specific knowledge to make good decisions and understand project's alignment with the broader strategy*
 - b. Highlight the project's impact. How has this project resulted in significant response and/or changes.

 - a. All submission packets and contents become the property of PMI Chicagoland Chapter and will not be returned.
 - b. Authorizations, clearances, consents necessary for public releases are obtained and submitted.
 - c. The PMI Chicagoland Chapter will not reimburse any expenses for assembling the nomination package or related materials to support the nomination.
 - d. The PMI Chicagoland Chapter Project of the Year Selection Committee is not obligated to extend the award if there are no projects meeting the required criteria.
